THE BLUE ECONOMY IN THE PA


- In Spain

 the maritime sectors are of great importance in our economy
- 4.872 km of coasts in the Iberian Peninsula
- Two archipelagos: The Balearic and the Canary Islands
- 3.011 km of coasts in these islands
- 80% of the Spanish perimeter is surrounded by the sea.
- The blue economy represents > 2,7% of the Spanish GDP.
- Generates > 480.000 employments
- Indirect effects make these figures higher (around 9% of GDP)



PRIORITIES AND OBJECTIVES IN THE ACTION PLAN



Priority 1: Promote entrepreneurship and innovation

- OEA0101: sharing knowledge between higher education organisations, companies and research centres
- OEA0102: enhancement of competitiveness and innovation capacities in the maritime economy of the Atlantic area
- OEA0103: fostering adaptation and diversification of economic activities by promoting the potential of the Atlantic area

Priority 2: Protect, secure and develop the potential of the Atlantic marine and coastal environment

- OEA0201: improving maritime safety and security
- OEA0202: exploring and protecting marine waters and coastal zones
- OEA0203: sustainable management of marine resources





INTERVENTIONS (ERDF FUND)



- **R&D&innovation:** R&D infrastructures in Atlantic regions.
 - R&D projects in marine or maritime fields.
- ICT: projects to improve processing, labeling, traceability and certification of fisheries and aquaculture products. Surveillance and observing mechanisms of the ocean.
- SMEs: projects to support SMEs in the following sectors:
 - marine sport, marinas and nautical leisure activities;
 - port services, cruise passengers;
 - cultural and natural attractions of the Atlantic seaboard;
 - tourist, coastal and underwater cultural attractions and maritime heritage sites, with archaeological, ecological or historical value.
- Low carbon economy: interconnections of electrical systems in the Canary Islands. R&D in the field of renewable energies.
- Risk management and climate change: risk management projects, actions to address climate change → to enhance safety and security of coastal populations and ecosystems.
- Natural resources and environment: natural, cultural and touristic heritage projects. Water treatment projects.
- Sustainable transport: projects on ports
