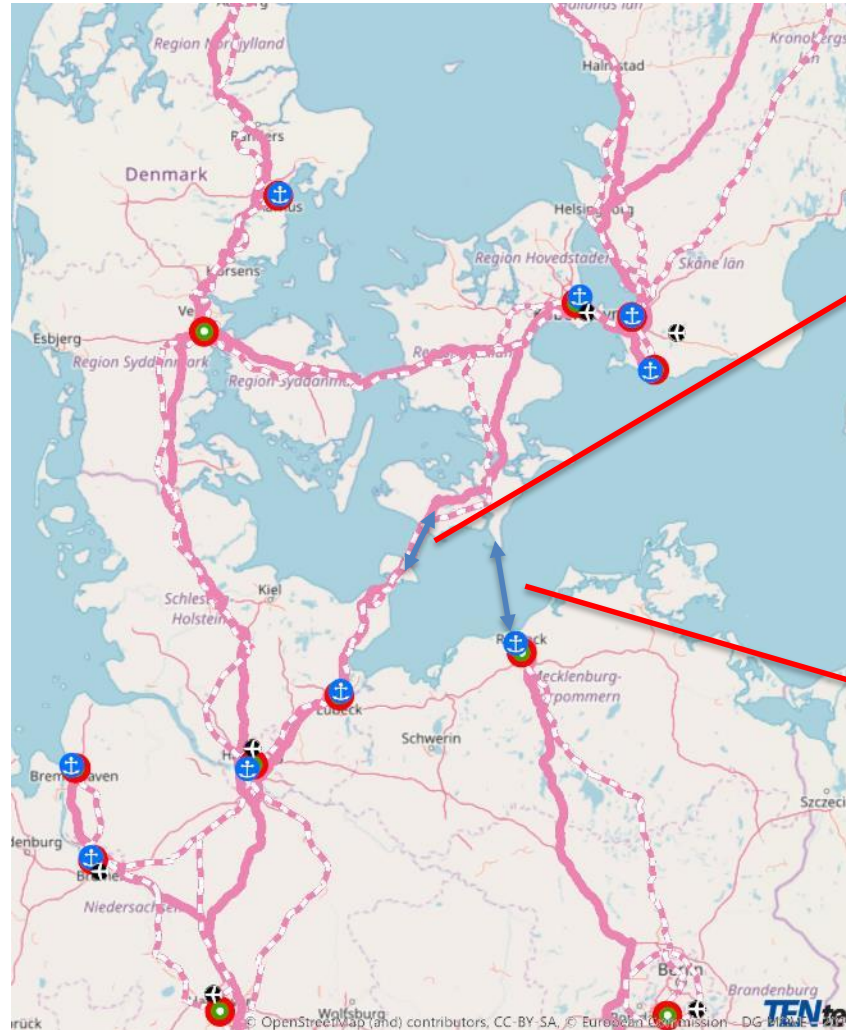


Our ferry services are a vital part of EU's Scandinavian Mediterranean (Scan-Med) Corridor

- 2 ferry routes between Germany and Denmark
- Owner and operator of ports in Gedser, Rødby & Puttgarden
- High frequency and large capacity, crossing times up to 2 hours
- Reliable transportation services for passengers and freight customers
- Catering services and retail sales of goods on board and ashore
- Zero emission vision for future ferry operation



Puttgarden-Rødby

- 5 ferries (4 hybrid)
- Departures every 30 min
 - Additional departures for freight customers
- ~110 daily departures
- 5.5m passenger p.a.*
- 1.4m cars p.a.*
- 530,000 lorries p.a.*

Rostock-Gedser

- 2 ferries (hybrid)
- Departures every 2 hrs
- ~21 daily departures
- 1.7m passenger p.a.*
- 340,000 cars p.a.*
- 150,00 trucks p.a.*

- Installed in May 2020
- Testing phase nearly finished
- Speed test in March 2021 confirmed performance expectations (4-5% savings on average)
- Part of Interreg „WASP“ project including 5 pilot installations of different wind-assisted technologies including performance validation and business case assessment
