- SMEs working with Universities to define
 a Master course applied to health, nutrition & aquaculture
- Scientific course + soft skills + training period

- Annual Blue Career Calls (EMFF) –
 More budget
- Sustainability ensured via Erasmus + /
 Erasmus Mundus programme to support student mobility
- strengthen partnerships between SMEs, Universities and Regions to develop innovative training for marine graduates (e.g. "Mates" project)
- ESF+ should take into account Smart
 Specialisation Strategy
